


COVID-19 Guideline for offline reporting in Darbhanga Medical College of PG candidate (AIQ & BSQ).

- (1) Due to COVID-19 situation, all candidates shall have to wear mask compulsorily and they shall be checked at the entry gate by the thermal gun for body temperature.
- (2) No guardian / parent is allowed with candidates
- (3) Candidate are hereby advised to avoid crowding at entry & exit points and maintain social distancing throughout the counselling venue.
- (4) Candidates are required to sanitize their hands with sanitizer before making entry to admission hall.
- (5) No candidate shall be allowed to throw used gloves and masks within premises of Darbhanga Medical College. In any adverse situation they shall drop the used waste in pedal push covered bin
- (6) Students will be provided admission form and bond format. They will fill up the form and will get duly signed bond paper from the Judicial Magistrate of the court of Darbhanga Medical College.



The certificate will be in serial as follows. Filled form with original and self attested Photostat copy of certificates will be submitted for verification. After satisfaction of authority they will deposit money and then they will be allotted hostel to shift in that.

 - c) Certificate of Economical Weaker Section (EWS).
 - d) Disability certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorised Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the rights of person s with Disability Act, 2016. **No other PwD certificate, issued by any other Authorities/Hospital will be entertained.** The format of **Certificate of Disability** is attached as ANNEXURE-1.

15. Bond paper in the format given (Rs. 1000 stamp paper by Judicial Magistrate from the Judicial territory of Darbhanga).
